



Refuse Collection Schedule and Terms of Service

Effective November 2018

Tenants, occupiers and business owners are advised of the collection times for refuse:

Terms of Service:

- 1. Refuse is only to be put out for collection at the times listed above.
- 2. All refuse must be placed in a City approved wheelie bin or appropriately bagged then placed next to the curb so as not to cause unreasonable impediment to pedestrians.
- 3. Cardboard boxes may be placed out for collection provided that they are collapsed and tied together. No wet refuse is to be placed in carboard boxes. All small boxes must be bagged or otherwise contained and secure.
- 4. All wet refuse must be bagged and placed in a green wheelie bin.
- 5. All wheelie bins must have a lid, be clearly labelled with the address of the owner and kept in a clean condition.
- 6. All wheelie bins must be removed from the sidewalk/road after they have been emptied.
- 7. Cooking grease must be placed out for collection in sturdy leak proof plastic containers.
- 8. Bulky refuse collection (e.g. appliances, computers, furniture) is done by appointment only with the Asst. Sanitation Supervisor 504-8261. The City of Hamilton will only collect small loads at the discretion of the Sanitation Supervisor. Customers must make their own arrangements for larger loads.
- 9. All refuse for recycling must be put out in a blue wheelie bin or blue plastic bags.
- 10. Items such as plastic bread trays, milk containers, wooden pallets, etc. must be stored inside the owner's premises at all times. The City does not collect these items.
- 11. No garden, foliage or construction waste will be collected.
- 12. No hazardous materials will be collected. See the Government Blue Pages for what goes where.
- 13. Any person who fails to comply with these requirements, causing the City of Hamilton to provide extraordinary services, will be charged a minimum service fee of \$500.00.
