

CUSTOMS TARIFF AMENDMENT (NO. 3) BILL 2018

HON. CURTIS DICKINSON, TO MOVE:

I MOVE that the Bill be amended:

In Clause 3 of the Bill by repealing and replacing the table for “CPC 4232” with following:

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Description	Goods for seniors' housing
CPC	4232
Duty Rate	0%
Eligible Beneficiary	All importers
Qualifying Goods	All goods
End-Use Conditions / Restrictions	<p>1. Goods must be incorporated in or installed on residential care home premises housing a senior (or any other premises housing a senior) or a home or premises housing a disabled person.</p> <p>2. Goods must be used for the purpose of enhancing seniors or a disabled person's mobility, safety and comfort.</p> <p>3. The Director of the Department of Ageing and Disability Services shall certify that the goods are eligible for this relief.</p>

	<p>4. In this CPC—</p> <p>“disabled person” shall have the same meaning as in section 2 of the Residential Care Homes and Nursing Homes Act 1999;</p> <p>“residential care home” shall have the same meaning as in section 2 of the Residential Care Homes and Nursing Homes Act 1999;</p> <p>“senior” means a person who is 65 years or older;</p> <p>“unconnected” shall have the same meaning as in section 2 of the Residential Care Homes and Nursing Homes Act 1999.</p>
Specific Controls / Diversion	The Director of Ageing and Disability Services shall certify that the goods that are eligible for relief are in accordance with policy guidelines issued by the Minister and published in such manner as he sees fit.
Construction	For the avoidance of doubt, the general provisions of this Schedule shall be construed as one with this CPC.

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
