WATSON, has been an integral part and partner with over 100 U.S. Mayors in their cities including, Miami, Tampa, and Orlando and has received over 250 awards for his work with black youth nationwide, among them five White House citations for his outstanding work with black youth; and

WHEREAS, DENNIS RAHIIM WATSON, served as the Youth Luncheon Speaker at the 30th National Conference on Preventing Crime in the Black Community, delivered the keynote address "Black Love in the Afternoon-Getting Black Males to Respect Black Females and each other to end Petty Beefs, Conflicts and Senseless Gun Violence NOW"; and
