NURSING AMENDMENT RULES 2018

BR 150 / 2018

The Minister of Health, in exercise of the power conferred by section 9 of the Nursing and Midwifery Act 1997, makes the following Rules:

Citation

These Rules, which amend the Nursing Rules 2010 (the "principal Rules"), may be cited as the Nursing Amendment Rules 2018.

Amends title of principal Rules

The principal Rules are amended by revoking the title of the Rules and substituting the title "Nursing and Midwifery Rules 2010".

Amends rule 2

- 3 The principal Rules are amended in rule 2 by inserting in the appropriate alphabetical position the following definition— $\,$
 - " "midwife" means a person who-
 - (a) has completed a midwifery education programme that is duly recognized by the Bermuda Nursing and Midwifery Council;
 - (b) has acquired requisite qualifications to be registered in Bermuda or a jurisdiction recognized by the Bermuda Nursing and Midwifery Council.".

Amends rule 3

 $4\,$ The principal Rules are amended by revoking rule 3 and substituting the following—

"Register

- 3 $\,$ (1) The register shall set out the particulars referred to in paragraph (2) and shall consist of divisions as follows—
 - (a) the nurses and nursing associates division, which shall be divided into parts as follows—
 - (i) Part A, which shall contain a list of the names of persons who are registered as nurse specialists;
 - (ii) Part B, which shall contain a list of the names of persons who are registered as general nurses;
 - (iii) Part C, which shall contain a list of the names of persons who are registered as advanced practice nurses;
 - (iv) Part D, which shall contain a list of the names of persons who are registered as nursing associates; and
 - (b) the midwives division.
- (2) The register shall, in addition to the provisions of section 4(2) of the Act, set out—
 - (a) the full name and address of the registered person;
 - (b) the person's qualifications;
 - (c) the branch or branches of nursing practice in relation to which every person is registered and any specialty; and
 - (d) the date of the person's registration.".

Amends rule 5

5 The principal Rules are amended in rule 5 by deleting "or nursing associate" and substituting ", nursing associate or midwife".
