PHARMACY AND POISONS (THIRD AND FOURTH SCHEDULE
AMENDMENT) ORDER 2019

The Minister responsible for health, in exercise of the power conferred by section 48A of the Pharmacy and Poisons Act 1979, makes the following Order:

Citation

1 This order, which amends the Pharmacy and Poisons Act 1979 (“the Act”), may be cited as the Pharmacy and Poisons (Third and Fourth Schedule Amendment) Order 2019.
