Sample/Methodology

- Global Research interviewed a representative sample of 402 registered voters in Bermuda. Surveys were collected online and via telephone interviews.
- All interviews were collected between September 9 13th, 2020.

Weighting

The results were weighted to be representative of Bermuda's population on the following factors: gender, age, and race.

Margin of Error

■ The margin of error for the study is +/- 4.9% at the 95% confidence level.



Biggest Issue Facing Bermuda Today


 Voters stated that the biggest issues facing Bermuda today were the economy (49%), unemployment (25%) and education (14%).

12% approved of the OBA's performance as opposition, 64% disapproved and 24% were unsure.



 42% approved of the formation of the Freedom Democratic Movement, compared to 21% who disapproved and 37% who were unsure.



76% approved of David Burt's performance as Premier, compared to 9% who disapproved and 15% who were unsure.



 37% approved of Marc Bean as leader of Freedom Democratic Movement (FDM), compared to 21% who disapproved and 42% who were unsure.

Parliamentary Voting In Last Election - July 18th, 2017

- 56% stated that they voted PLP, compared to 31% who voted OBA and 1% who stated that they voted for an independent.
- 5% stated that they did not vote and 6% refused to give a response.

Voting Intention

- If an election were held tomorrow, 50% would vote PLP, 17% would vote OBA and 8% would vote for the FDM.
- 14% stated they were undecided on who they would vote for. 1% stated they would vote for an Independent, 1% stated that they would spoil their ballot, and 8% refused to give a response.
