PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over Bermuda.

WHEREAS it is provided by Section 48 of the Constitution of Bermuda that each session of the Legislature shall be held in such place and shall commence at such time as the Governor may appoint by proclamation published in the Gazette;

AND WHEREAS the Legislature was dissolved on the 21st day of August, two thousand and twenty:

NOW THEREFORE I, the Governor, acting in accordance with the advice which I have received from the Premier, DO APPOINT that the next session of the Legislature shall commence at 10:00 a.m. on Friday, the 6th day of November, two thousand and twenty, and that the Senate and the House of Assembly shall meet on that day at Their Majesties' Chappell, St. Peter's Church, St. George's;

AND I DO FURTHER APPOINT that thereafter the Senate and the House of Assembly shall meet on the Fourth Floor of Veritas Place, 65 Court Street in the City of Hamilton.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of Bermuda this 30th day of October, two thousand and twenty, in the sixty-ninth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
