



Golf Development Officer

The Bermuda Golf Association (BGA) and Bermuda Golf Foundation (Charity #141) are jointly seeking a part-time Golf Development Officer (GDO). The GDO will work a maximum of 20 hours per week and will be responsible for delivering grassroots and junior golf development programming. As the National Sport Governing Body, the BGA is committed to delivering a strategic plan to grow, develop and sustain the game of golf in Bermuda. The successful candidate will play an integral role in reducing the barriers of entry and promoting diversity, inclusion and equality in the game of golf across the island.

The GDO will be tasked with:

- Delivering an island-wide Golf In School program.
- Administering after-school and school holiday golf camps.
- Assisting the ongoing junior athlete development program.

Additional duties will include working closely with the BGA Administrator to support the preparation and running of BGA golf tournaments.

The successful applicant must:

- Be in good standing with the BGA and Bermuda Professional Golfers' Association.
- Be experienced in sport development and possess a passion for the game of golf.
- Be interested in teaching and mentoring young children.
- Be willing to work flexible hours to cover evenings and weekends during the golf season.
- Possess strong administrative, organisational, verbal and written communication skills, with computer literacy in such programs as Microsoft Word and Excel.
- Have an engaging personality to work with community partners and volunteers.

Requirements and Experience

- Valid police check and SCARS certification.
- Strong understanding of the game of golf, including the Rules of Golf and etiquette.
- Good communication of sports skills, with a grasp of LTAD principles.
- Access to a private car for transporting necessary equipment.
- Evidence of golf-related continuing professional development is desirable.

This job has the potential for growth to a full-time position for the right candidate and there may be opportunities for CPD support in the future.
