PUBLIC HEALTH (COVID-19 EMERGENCY POWERS) AMENDMENT (NO. 3)  
REGULATIONS 2021

Her Excellency the Governor, on the advice of the Minister responsible for health, and in exercise of the power conferred by section 107B of the Public Health Act 1949, makes the following Regulations:

Citation

1 These Regulations, which amend the Public Health (COVID-19 Emergency Powers) Regulations 2021 (“the principal Regulations”), may be cited as the Public Health (COVID-19 Emergency Powers) Amendment (No. 3) Regulations 2021.

Amends regulation 2

2 In regulation 2 of the principal Regulations (interpretation), delete the definition of “curfew”.

Revokes regulation 3 and Schedule 1

3 (1) Regulation 3 of the principal Regulations (night-time curfew) is revoked.

(2) In consequence, Schedule 1 to the principal Regulations (persons exempt from curfew) is revoked.

Amends regulation 6

4 In regulation 6 of the principal Regulations (bars, clubs and sale of intoxicating liquor), in paragraphs (1), (3) and (4), delete “11pm” and substitute “midnight”.

Commencement

5 These Regulations shall come into effect at 6am on 18 February 2021.
