The Ministry of Public Works wishes to inform the public that the ongoing embankment & wall repairs along Harbour Road in the vicinity of Burnt House Hill and Tamarind Vale Street will need to be extended until April 16, 2021.

Working hours will be from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm week days.


Traffic controls will be under direction of Ministry of Public Works representatives and will be managed through traffic control signals & signage.

The public is advised to avoid Harbour Road between Burnt House Hill and Tamarind Vale Street and to use detour route via Middle Road.

The Ministry of Public Works wishes to encourage the full cooperation of the public and apologizes for any inconvenience that may result.
