

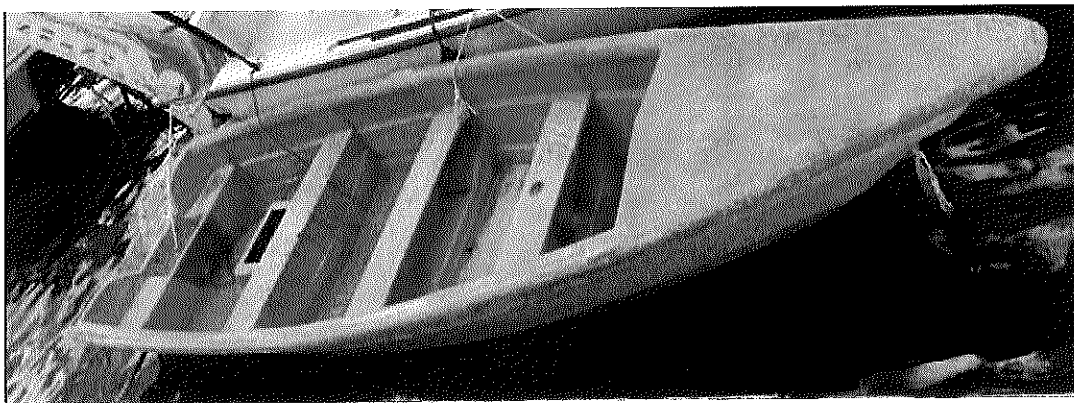
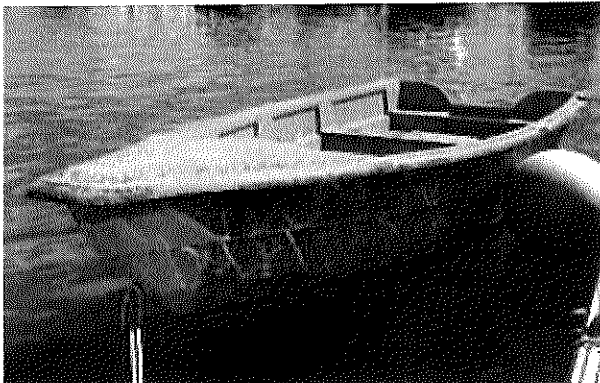
NOTICE OF WRECK

The Merchant Shipping Act 2002

Pursuant to the provisions of section 202 of the Merchant Shipping Act 2002, I hereby give notice that the vessel described below was salvaged from the waters off Bermuda, and has come into the possession of the Receiver of Wreck:-

Condition of Vessel

This vessel was discovered upside down and in a semi-submerged state NW of the island. It would appear that the vessel has been semi-submerged for a length of time based on sea growth found attached. A general inspection of the hull indicates that the hull is saturated with sea water.
