LANE CLOSURE EXTENSION III FOR BLDC TRENCH WORKS

EXTENDED UNTIL MONDAY, OCTOBER 31st, 2022

The Ministry of Public Works wishes to inform motorists that the ongoing BLDC's trench work from Rocky Hill Park to Ferry Reach Road will continue a one lane closure up until Monday, 31st October, 2022.

The trench work has switched over from the Mullet Bay Road westbound lane into the eastbound lane at Ferry Reach Road bus layby to approach the Echo Lane trench.

Working hours will be from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm, weekly from Monday through Saturday.

Motorists, especially construction vehicles, buses and taxis are asked to exercise extreme caution when passing the open trench since it may at times be near the center yellow line which can pose some danger.

Traffic controls will be under the direction of Island Construction Services Ltd. representatives and will be managed through traffic control signs and signals.

The Ministry of Public Works wishes to encourage the full cooperation of the public and apologizes for any inconvenience that may result.
