

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1947

ROAD TRAFFIC (BERMUDA TRIATHLON ASSOCIATION INTERNATIONAL CARIFTA TRIATHLON BICYCLE ROAD RACE) (VARIATION OF SPEED LIMITS) (NO. 2) ORDER 2022

The Minister responsible for works and engineering, in exercise of the power conferred by section 7(2A) of the Road Traffic Act 1947, makes the following Order:


1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Bermuda Triathlon Association International Carifta Triathlon Bicycle Road Race) (Variation of Speed Limits) (No. 2) Order 2022.
2. This Order applies to the contestants and to the vehicles attendant on the contestants in the Bermuda Triathlon Association International Carifta Triathlon Bicycle Road Race on Bermuda Land Development Company Limited roadways in St. George's Parish to be held on Saturday, 12th November 2022 and Sunday, 13th November 2022.
3. The speed limits fixed by section 7(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Act 1947 in respect of the roads outside the municipal area of the Town of St. George specified in the second column of the Schedule (the "relevant roads") are hereby varied to the extent specified in the first column of the Schedule in respect of the contestants and the vehicles attendant on the contestants in the Bermuda Triathlon Association International Carifta Triathlon Bicycle Road Race.
4. The relevant roads or parts thereof specified in the second column of the Schedule are hereby declared to be subject, at the times specified in the third column of the Schedule, in respect of the contestants and the vehicles attendant on the contestants in the Bermuda Triathlon Association International Carifta Triathlon Bicycle Road Race, to the speed limit specified in the first column thereof.

SCHEDULE

75 kilometres per hour	Commencing on Cooper's Island Road head northerly along Cooper's Island Road to the Southside Road roundabout, then continue along Pepper Hall Road and head northerly towards Tommy Fox Road, then turn left and head towards Southside Road, then continue along Southside Road to the White's roundabout, at the junction of Longfield Road and Westcott Road and head easterly along Southside Road, until reaching the junction at Tommy Fox Road, then turn right and travel in a southerly direction to the Southside Road roundabout and then continue in a southerly direction along Cooper's Island Road to the finish line.	8:25am to 11:00am on Saturday 11:25am to 1:15pm on Sunday

ROAD TRAFFIC (BERMUDA TRIATHLON ASSOCIATION INTERNATIONAL CARIFTA TRIATHLON BICYCLE ROAD RACE) (NO. 2) ORDER 2022

The Minister responsible for works and engineering, in exercise of the power conferred by section 4 of the Road Traffic Act 1947, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Bermuda Triathlon Association International Carifta Triathlon Bicycle Road Race) (No. 2) Order 2022.
2. This Order applies in respect of the Bermuda Triathlon Association International Carifta Triathlon Bicycle Road Race (the "bicycle race") on Bermuda Land Development Company Limited roadways in St. George's Parish to be held on Saturday, 12th November and Sunday, 13th November 2022.
3. The bicycle race will follow the route specified below.
4. The Commissioner of Police is hereby authorized to close roads or portions of roads and authorize parking as the Commissioner of Police decides in the interests of public safety.


RACE ROUTE: Commencing on Cooper's Island Road head northerly along Cooper's Island Road to the Southside Road roundabout, then continue along Pepper Hall Road and head northerly towards Tommy Fox Road, then turn left and head towards Southside Road, then continue along Southside Road to the White's roundabout, at the junction of Longfield Road and Westcott Road and head easterly along Southside Road, until reaching the junction at Tommy Fox Road, then turn right and travel in a southerly direction to the Southside Road roundabout and then continue in a southerly direction along Cooper's Island Road to either complete one lap or until reaching the finish line.

TRAFFIC CONTROL: The bicycle race will commence on Saturday, November 12th 2022 at 8:25am and is expected to conclude by 11:00am and Sunday, 13th November 2022 at 11:25am and is expected to conclude by 1:15pm. All motorists are expected to use caution and to avoid collision with race participants. The race route will be under the control of the police and race officials. Motorists must follow instructions from race officials to assist with traffic control for this event.

ROADS CLOSED: There will be no roads closed to traffic while the bicycle race takes place.

PARKING: There will be no parking restrictions in place for the bicycle race, with motorists permitted to park in designated parking bays along any part of the race route. Additionally, motorists must not block the race route or impede the participants in the bicycle race.
