


ICT Sector Gross Domestic Product

- Information and Communication Technology (ICT) contributed \$190 million (2.6 per cent) to Gross Domestic Product (GDP) in current prices in 2021 (Figure 1).
- This sector's GDP in current prices increased 10.1 per cent from 2020 due to a 16.0 per cent increase in Content and Media Industries and a 10.3 per cent increase in Services Industries.




IT Professionals and ICT-Related Employment

- In 2021, employment of IT Professionals declined by 3.2 per cent to 421 filled jobs from 2020. These jobs accounted for 1.3 per cent of total filled jobs (**Figure 3**).
- ICT-Related Employment declined to 843 filled jobs (4.3 per cent) from 2020 and comprised 2.7 per cent of total filled jobs in 2021 (Figure 3).




Capital Investment in ICT

- In 2021, capital investment in ICT increased 32.3 per cent to \$63 million due to a 42.4 per cent rise in purchases of computer software (Figure 2). Purchases in ICT equipment also increased by 19.5 per cent from 2020.
- Higher capital investment occurred primarily in computer software at \$17.3 million in the International Business sector and \$16.8 million in the Financial and Insurance Activities sector in 2021.



Trade in ICT and Content Goods and Services

- Bermuda's ICT trade deficit expanded by 21.0 per cent to \$88 million in 2021 (Figure 4).
- This can be attributed to a 47.1 per cent increase in imported telecommunication equipment. However, there was a 21.5 per cent decrease in the export of ICT Services.




Gross Median Annual Income for ICT-Related Jobs

Software and Application Developers and Analysts earned the highest median income of \$130,667 in 2021; an increase of 3.0 per cent year-over-year whilst, Computer Professionals' median income increased by 1.2 per cent to \$104,143 in 2021, Physical and Engineering Science Technicians' median income declined by 1.6 per cent, to \$73,400 in 2021 (Figure 5).




Business Use of Internet by Activity

- The leading uses of the internet by businesses were sending or receiving e-mails (93.4 per cent), internet banking (89.7 per cent), obtaining information about goods and services (85.6 per cent), getting information from government (83.7 per cent) and interacting with government services (80.3 per cent).
- Telephoning via the internet was used by 67.6 per cent of businesses (Figure 7).




Composition of Trade in ICT Services Imports

• Computer Services accounted for 65.0 per cent of all imported ICT Services, increasing from 2020 by 1.7 percentage points. Telecommunications Services accounted for 27.5 per cent and Information Services comprised 7.5 per cent of total ICT Services Imports (Figure 6).



Business Use of ICT

• In 2021, 93.5 per cent of businesses surveyed used the internet for business operations. Computers were used by 91.9 per cent of businesses, 86.4 per cent of businesses connected via broadband, Wi-Fi enabled devices were used 83.1 per cent by businesses and 78.7 per cent of businesses used smartphones. There was a decline in businesses outsourcing IT services by 9.9 percentage points from 2020 (Figure 8).
