

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1947

ROAD TRAFFIC (WORLD TRIATHLON CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES BERMUDA ROAD CLOSURES)  
ORDER 2022

The Minister responsible for works and engineering, in exercise of the power conferred by section 4 of the Road Traffic Act 1947, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (World Triathlon Championship Series Bermuda Road Closures) Order 2022.
2. The Minister responsible for works and engineering notifies the public that the World Triathlon Championship Series Bermuda will be holding a road race on Saturday, 5th November 2022 and Sunday, 6th November 2022 between the hours of 7:00am and 6:00pm on various roads in and outside of the City of Hamilton.
3. The bicycle race routes are as follows:

**The AG bicycle race route on Saturday is as follows: This race will begin by exiting the City Hall car parking lot and will head south onto Dismont Drive then east onto Church Street, then south onto Burnaby Street to Reid Street then head east again. At Parliament Street it will head south to Front Street. There along Front Street it will continue down East Broadway and down Crow Lane and up Trimmingham Road. On Trimmingham Road near south Road roundabout it will make a u-turn and head back down Trimmingham Road, up Crow Lane to Flora Duffy Hill. Then north up Flora Duffy Hill to Middle Road to head east. It will continue down Middle Road to Fort Hill Road to make another u-turn to head back west down Middle Road to Cavendish Road and continue west onto Reid Street to head north onto Parliament Street, then west onto Church Street to Burnaby Street to continue north to Victoria Street. On Victoria Street it will head west past Victoria Park to Washington Street to head slightly north then west again on Park Road and continue west along to Serpentine Road. On Serpentine Road it will continue west to Pitts Bay Road to head southeasterly to Woodbourne Avenue then north onto Woodbourne Avenue to Richmond Road to head east to Bermudiana Road to head south. From Bermudiana Road it will turn east on Rosebank Road to Par-La-Ville Road to again head north to reach Church Street, on Church Street it will head east back towards Hamilton City Hall car parking lot to head north on Wesley Street back to Victoria Street to head east to Dismont Drive to go south and back into the City Hall car parking lot.**


**The Elite bicycle race route on Sunday is as follows: The bike race will begin on Front Street west of Burnaby Street and head east down Front Street, east on East Broadway and east on Crow Lane. On Crow Lane near Trimmingham roundabout it makes a u-turn to head up Crow Lane to enter Flora Duffy Hill to head east northerly. At Middle Road it will continue east to Montpelier Road and make a u-turn back west on Middle Road to Cavendish Road and continue west onto Reid Street. From Reid Street head south onto Court Street to head west again onto Front Street to Parliament Street. From there it will head north on Parliament Street to Reid Street again to head west down to Queen Street to head south to Pitts Bay Road. From there it will head to Bermudiana Road to head north to Gorham Road to head west to Woodbourne Avenue, then east on Pitts Bay Road back to Front Street.**


4. Roads will be closed during the races. Motorists are advised to use caution and alternative routes, giving priority to cyclists. Motorists are also advised to follow directions given by the police and race marshals. The roads affected by the road closures for these races are as follows:

5. There will be parking restrictions in place during the bicycle race, and motorists are required to park at alternative sites to assist with the open roadways required for this bicycle race route. When needing access to the resident's property, motorists need to communicate with the police or race marshals to learn the best way to access or depart from their residences.
