**TEMPORARY STREET CLOSURE
FOR
EMERGENCY TREE TRIMMING**

MONDAY, JULY 17TH, 2023 THROUGH TUESDAY, JULY 18TH, 2023

The Ministry of Public Works wishes to inform motorists that Suffering Lane in St. Georges will undergo landscaping work for overhanging tree trimming along the Five Forts Golf Course edge.

The work will require emergency temporary street closure that commences on Monday, July 17th, 2023 through Tuesday, July 18th, 2023. Suffering Lane will be temporary closed from Boundary Lane through to Khyber Pass from 9 am to 5 pm both days.

Residents are advised to use alternative routes via Wellington Hill Lane and Khyber Pass.

Note that for the duration of the tree trimming Khyber Pass may be used as a two-way road. Proceed through it with care.


Pedestrians and pedal bike riders are advised to proceed through this area with caution.

Traffic control will be managed by St. Regis Hotel representatives through cones and signage.
