

Honouring 175 Years of Portuguese Heritage in Bermuda A FREE Digital Storytelling Workshop

What:

We are seeking people of Portuguese descent who live or have lived in Bermuda to participate in a free 6-week digital storytelling workshop conducted on-line. Digital story experts will guide you through the process of crafting a short three-minute digital video about your family story and experiences. Post workshop, a private live screening of the videos will take place for participants.

Why:

To honour of the 175th Anniversary of the arrival of the first immigrants of Portuguese descent at Bermuda, **National Museum of Bermuda** and **Portuguese Cultural Association of Bermuda** and have joined forces with **StoryCenter** (US based non profit) to collect stories and experiences of Bermuda's vibrant Portuguese community.

Through these digital stories, personal histories of the past will intertwine with the present to help us understand the enduring legacies we carry that add to our shared history.

Requirements and time commitment:

- No prior knowledge or skills necessary, only the willingness to craft and share your story
- 2 hours per week for 6 weeks (total 12 hours)
- Computer, internet access, conversational english proficiency
- Must be at least 18 years or older
