

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1947

ROAD TRAFFIC (BERMUDA BICYCLE ASSOCIATION WINNERS EDGE TIME TRIAL BICYCLE ROAD RACE) ORDER 2024

The Minister responsible for works and engineering, in exercise of the power conferred by section 4 of the Road Traffic Act 1947, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Bermuda Bicycle Association Winners Edge Time Trial Bicycle Road Race) Order 2024.
2. This Order applies in respect of the Bermuda Bicycle Association Winners Edge Time Trial Bicycle Road Race (the “bicycle race”) on the roadways between Paget and Southampton Parishes to be held on Sunday, 21st April 2024.
3. The bicycle race will follow the route specified below.
4. The Commissioner of Police is hereby authorized to close roads or portions of roads and authorize parking as the Commissioner of Police decides in the interests of public safety.

RACE ROUTE: The time trial for the 11–14 year-old category commences and finishes on Stonington Avenue near South Road in Paget Parish. The participants travel west along South Road through Warwick Parish and turnaround at the Horseshoe Road junction in Southampton Parish and travel back towards the finish line. The time trial for all other categories commences and finishes on Stonington Avenue. The participants travel west along South Road, until Church Bay Park in Southampton Parish. There they will use the Park layby as a turnaround to return onto South Road to travel east back to the finish line at Stonington Avenue in Paget Parish.

TRAFFIC CONTROL: The bicycle race will commence on Sunday, 21st April 2024 at 7:15am and is expected to conclude by 9:30am. All motorists are expected to use caution and to avoid collision with race participants. The race route will be under the control of the police and race officials. Motorists must follow instructions from race officials to assist with traffic control for this event.

ROADS CLOSED: There will be no roads closed to traffic while the bicycle race takes place.

PARKING: There will be no parking restrictions in place for the bicycle race, with motorists permitted to park in designated parking bays along any part of the race route. Additionally, motorists must not block the race route or impede the participants in the bicycle race.
