

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1947

ROAD TRAFFIC (BERMUDA BICYCLE ASSOCIATION WINNERS EDGE TIME TRIAL BICYCLE ROAD RACE) (VARIATION OF SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2024

The Minister responsible for works and engineering, in exercise of the power conferred by section 7(2A) of the Road Traffic Act 1947, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Bermuda Bicycle Association Winners Edge Time Trial Bicycle Road Race) (Variation of Speed Limits) Order 2024.
2. This Order applies to the contestants and to the vehicles attendant on the contestants in the Bermuda Bicycle Association Winners Edge Time Trial Bicycle Road Race on roadways between Paget and Southampton Parishes to be held on Sunday, 21st April 2024.
3. The speed limits fixed by section 7(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Act 1947 are hereby varied to the extent specified in the first column of the Schedule in respect of the contestants and the vehicles attendant on the contestants in the Bermuda Bicycle Association Winners Edge Time Trial Bicycle Road Race.
4. The relevant roads or parts thereof specified in the second column of the Schedule are hereby declared to be subject, at the times specified in the third column of the Schedule, in respect of the contestants and the vehicles attendant on the contestants in the Bermuda Bicycle Association Winners Edge Time Trial Bicycle Road Race, to the speed limit specified in the first column thereof.

SCHEDULE

SPEED LIMIT	ROADS	TIMES
75 kilometres per hour	The time trial for the 11–14 year-old category commences and finishes on Stonington Avenue near South Road in Paget Parish. The participants travel west along South Road through Warwick Parish and turnaround at the Horseshoe Road junction in Southampton Parish and travel back towards the finish line. The time trial for all other categories commences and finishes on Stonington Avenue. The participants travel west along South Road, until Church Bay Park in Southampton Parish. There they will use the Park layby as a turnaround to return onto South Road to travel east back to the finish line at Stonington Avenue in Paget Parish.	7:15am to 9:30am
