## **BNG RUN FOR THE ARTS 5K**

SUNDAY, APRIL 21st, 2024

The Ministry of Public Works wishes to inform motorists that the BNG Run for the Arts 5k will occur on Sunday, April 21<sup>st</sup>, 2024, between 8:30 am and 10:45 am. The following roads will be affected:

**RACE ROUTES:** 

The 5k race commences at the park on Parsons Road. The participants proceed along Parsons Road and turn left onto Union Street. They make another left turn onto Elliot Street and a right turn onto King Street. The participants turn left onto Curving Avenue and another left onto Happy Valley Road. They proceed along Happy Valley Road, then left onto Montpelier Road and continue to Frog Lane. They then turn left onto Palmetto Road. They continue on Palmetto Road to Marsh Folly Road and turn left onto Dutton Avenue. They make another left turn onto North Street and proceed to the finish line on Parsons Road.

TRAFFIC CONTROL:

The race will commence on Sunday, April 21<sup>st</sup>, 2024, at 8:30 am and is expected to conclude by 10:45 am. There will be Race Marshals present to direct traffic along the route.

**ROAD CLOSURES:** 

There will be no road closures for this event. All motorists are expected to use caution and avoid collisions with the race participants. The race will be under the control of Race Marshals. Motorists are asked to follow the instructions given by the Race Marshals to assist with traffic control for this event.

The Ministry of Public Works wishes to encourage the full cooperation of the motoring public and apologises for any inconvenience that may result.
