ROAD CLOSURES FOR THE WARWICK ACADEMY FUN RUN AND WALK

SUNDAY, APRIL 28th, 2024

The Ministry of Public Works wishes to inform motorists that the Warwick Academy Fun Run and Walk will occur on Sunday, April 28th, 2024, between 8:30 am and 10:00 am. There will be road closures to facilitate the race, and the following roads will be affected:

RACE ROUTES: The 1.5k race commences on Morgan Road. The participants turn left onto Harbour Road and proceed to the turnaround at the junction of Belmont Road and Harbour Road. They return to the finish line at the Warwick Academy Compound.

The 3k race commences on Morgan Road. The participants turn left onto Harbour Road and proceed to the turnaround just after the junction of Longford Road and Harbour Road. They return to the finish line at the Warwick Academy Compound.

The 5k race commences on Morgan Road. The participants turn left onto Harbour Road and proceed to the turnaround just after the Tamarind Vale and Harbour Road junction. They return to the finish line at the Warwick Academy Compound.

TRAFFIC CONTROL: The running/walking races will commence on Sunday, April 28th, 2024, at 8:30 am and are expected to conclude by 10:00 am. Road marshals will be present to direct traffic along the route.

ROAD CLOSURES: The following roads will be closed during this event:

- Harbour Road from Cobbs Hill Road to the junction of Burnt House Hill and Middle Road.
- The accesses to Harbour Road at the following junctions:

Cobbs Hill Road | Keith Hall Road | Tamarind Vale

The junction of Morgan Road and Middle Road will be closed at the start of the race only.

Additionally, Road Marshals will be stationed along the route and at the following junctions:

Morgan Road | Belmont Road | Warwick Park Road | Longford Road

All motorists are expected to use caution and avoid collisions with race participants. Motorists are advised to avoid the road closure locations and seek alternative routes on Middle Road and South Road.

Motorists are asked to follow the instructions given by the Race Marshals to assist with traffic control for this event.

The Ministry of Public Works wishes to encourage the full cooperation of the motoring public and apologises for any inconvenience that may result. Should there be any questions regarding this event, please direct queries to the attention of the race representative, Jill Finnigan at 505-8106.

In addition, the Bermuda police are hereby authorised to “Close-Off” streets or portions of streets and authorise parking as the Commissioner of Police decides.
