**SINGLE LANE CLOSURE
FOR
PAVING OF SOUTH ROAD AT HENRY VIII**

WEDNESDAY, MAY 8th, 2024 THROUGH FRIDAY, MAY 17th, 2024

The Ministry of Public Works wishes to inform the motoring public that a single lane closure will take place on South Road near Henry VIII, in Southampton. The lane closure will allow for the paving works to recommence between Henry VIII Restaurant and Southampton Princess Hotel entrance.

The lane closure will commence on Wednesday, May 8th, 2024 and will continue until Friday, May 17th, 2024.

The work shall take place weekdays between 8:00 am and 3:00 pm.

Traffic control will be under direction of Ministry of Public Works representatives and will be managed with 'Stop/Go' signs and traffic lights. For safety purposes, no vehicular access will be granted through the closed lane.

Motorists are advised to expect delays on South Road and on Middle Road near Jews Bay due to ongoing construction. Use alternative route via Lighthouse Road and Middle Road.

The Ministry of Public Works wishes to encourage the full cooperation of the public and apologizes for any inconvenience that may result.
