**ROLLING ROAD CLOSURES  
FOR  
TRANSPORT OF BELCO EQUIPMENT**

**SATURDAY, JULY 20<sup>TH</sup>, 2024**

The Ministry of Public Works wishes to inform the motoring public that there will be rolling road closures on Serpentine Road and Cemetery Road to accommodate the transport of large equipment for BELCO out of the City of Hamilton.

The road closure will start from Par-La-Ville Road at the roundabout, head west on Serpentine Road, and then go down to Cemetery Road to turn east at the roundabout to enter BELCO's North Power Station (NPS) site.

The road closure commences on Saturday, July 20<sup>th</sup>, 2024, at 7:00 am and is anticipated to take approximately 1 ½ hours.

Traffic control will be under the direction of BEST Shipping, TD&R Field Ops & BG Engineering representatives.

**Motorists are advised to use alternative routes, such as Woodlands Road to St. John's Road or Pitts Bay Road, to avoid this section on Serpentine Road.**
