SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 29TH, 2024

The Ministry of Public Works wishes to inform motorists that the Bermuda Bicycle Association BRCC Road Race will occur on Sunday, September 29th, 2024, between 7:30 am and 9:30 am. The following roads will be affected:

RACE ROUTE:

The bicycle race commences and concludes at the park on Harrington Sound Road. The participants proceed East on Harrington Sound Road and turn right onto Wilkinson Avenue. They proceed to the roundabout and exit onto North Shore Road. They continue North Shore Road until traversing the island at the junction of North Shore Road and Middle Road. The participants turn left onto Middle Road and make another left onto Harrington Sound Road. They proceed to the finish line at the park on Harrington Sound Road.

TRAFFIC CONTROL:

The bicycle race will commence on Sunday, September 29th, 2024, at 7:30 am and is expected to conclude by 9:30 am. All motorists are expected to use caution and to avoid collisions with race participants. The race route will be under the control of Police Officers and Race Marshals. Motorists must follow the instructions from the Police Officers and Race Marshals to assist with traffic control for this event.

ROAD CLOSURES:

There will be no roads closed to traffic while the bicycle race takes place.

The Ministry of Public Works wishes to encourage the full cooperation of the motoring public and apologises for any inconvenience that may result. In addition, the Bermuda police are hereby authorised to "Close off" streets or portions of streets and authorise parking as the Commissioner of Police decides.

ROAD TRAFFIC (BERMUDA BICYCLE ASSOCIATION BRCC BICYCLE ROAD RACE) (VARIATION OF SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2024

The Minister responsible for works and engineering, in exercise of the power conferred by section 7(2A) of the Road Traffic Act 1947, makes the following Order:

- This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Bermuda Bicycle Association BRCC Bicycle Road Race) (Variation of Speed Limits) Order 2024.
- This Order applies to the contestants and to the vehicles attendant on the contestants in the Bermuda Bicycle Association BRCC Bicycle Road Race on Ministry of Public Works roads to be held on Sunday, 29th September 2024.
- The speed limits fixed by section 7(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Act 1947 are hereby varied to the extent specified in the first column of the Schedule in respect of the contestants and the vehicles attendant on the contestants in the Bermuda Bicycle Association BRCC Bicycle Road Race.
- 4. The relevant roads or parts thereof specified in the second column of the Schedule are hereby declared to be subject, at the times specified in the third column of the Schedule, in respect of the contestants and the vehicles attendant on the contestants in the Bermuda Bicycle Association BRCC Bicycle Road Race, to the speed limit specified in the first column thereof.

ROAD TRAFFIC (BERMUDA BICYCLE ASSOCIATION BRCC BICYCLE ROAD RACE) ORDER 2024

The Minister responsible for works and engineering, in exercise of the power conferred by section 4(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Act 1947, makes the following Order:

- This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Bermuda Bicycle Association BRCC Bicycle Road Race) Order 2024.
- This Order applies in respect of the Bermuda Bicycle Association BRCC Bicycle Road Race (the "bicycle race") on Ministry of Public Works roads to be held on Sunday, 29th September 2024.
- The bicycle race will follow the route specified below.
- The Commissioner of Police is hereby authorized to close roads or portions of roads and authorize parking as the Commissioner of Police decides in the interests of public safety.

RACE ROUTE: Commencing at the park on Harrington Sound Road proceeding in a easterly direction along Harrington Sound Road, then turn right onto Wilkinson Avenue and proceed towards the Blue Hole Hill roundabout and exit onto North Shore Road and head west on North Shore Road towards Flatts Village, then stay left at the junction heading up Middle Road and make the left onto Harrington Sound Road and proceed to the finish line at the park on Harrington Sound Road.

TRAFFIC CONTROL: The bicycle race will commence on Sunday, 29th September

2024 at 7:30am and is expected to conclude by 9:30am. All motorists are required to use caution and to avoid collision with race participants. The race route will be under the control of the police and race officials. Motorists must follow instructions from

race officials to assist with traffic control for this event.

ROADS CLOSED: There will be no roads closed to traffic while the bicycle race

takes place.

PARKING: There will be no parking restrictions in place for the bicycle race,

with motorists permitted to park in designated parking bays along any part of the race route. Additionally, motorists must not block the race route or impede the participants in the bicycle race.
