**PROCLAMATION**

By Her Excellency, Governor and Commander-in-Chief  
in and over Bermuda.

WHEREAS Section 49 of the Constitution provides that  
the Governor, acting in accordance with the advice of the  
Premier, may at any time, by proclamation published in  
the Gazette, prorogue the Legislature:

NOW THEREFORE I, the Governor, acting in  
accordance with the advice which I have received from  
the Premier, DO PROROGUE THE LEGISLATURE on  
Thursday, the 7th day of November, two thousand and  
twenty-four.

this 23rd day of October, two thousand and twenty-four,  
in the third year of His Majesty's Reign.

**PROCLAMATION**

By Her Excellency, Governor and Commander-in-Chief  
in and over Bermuda.

WHEREAS it is provided by Section 48 of the  
Constitution of Bermuda that each session of the  
Legislature shall be held in such place and shall  
commence at such time as the Governor may appoint by  
proclamation published in the Gazette;

AND WHEREAS the present Legislature will stand  
prorogued on Thursday, the 7th day of November, two  
thousand and twenty-four:

NOW THEREFORE I, the Governor, acting in  
accordance with the advice which I have received from  
the Premier, DO APPOINT that, at the next session of  
the Legislature, the Senate shall meet in the Cabinet  
Building in the City of Hamilton and the House of  
Assembly shall meet on the Fourth Floor of Veritas  
Place, 65 Court Street in the City of Hamilton;

AND I DO FURTHER APPOINT that the next session of  
the Legislature shall commence at 10:00 a.m. on Friday,  
the 8th day of November, two thousand and twenty-four.
