The Ministry of Public Works wishes to inform motorists that the MAAC Beyond Fitness 5k will occur on Sunday, October 6th, 2024, between 8:30 am and 9:30 am. The following roads will be affected:

- RACE ROUTES: The race commences at the corner of Dundonald Street and Cedar Avenue. The participants turn right onto Marsh Folly Road and continue along Palmetto Road until turning left at the roundabout onto Dock Hill. They turn left onto North Shore Road and then left onto Blackwatch Pass. The participants turn right onto Marsh Folly Road, then left onto Cedar Avenue. They turn right onto Dundonald Street and proceed to the finish line at the Masters Home Centre carpark.
- **TRAFFIC CONTROL:** The race will commence on Sunday, October 6th, 2024, at 8:30 am and is expected to conclude by 9:30 am. Police officers and race marshals will be present to direct traffic along the route.
- **ROAD CLOSURES:** There will be no road closures for this event. All motorists are expected to use caution and avoid collisions with the race participants. The race will be under the control of Police Officers and Race Marshals. Motorists are asked to follow the instructions given by the Police Officers and Race Marshals to assist with traffic control for this event.
