**ROLLING LANE CLOSURE FOR PAVING WORKS & BELCO PULL HOLES**

**MONDAY, JANUARY 6<sup>th</sup>, 2025 TO FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 21<sup>st</sup>, 2025**

The Ministry of Public Works wishes to inform the motoring public that there will be lane closures on Middle Road, Warwick to allow for paving and BELCO pull-hole works to take place.

The lane closures will be between Camp Hill and Longford Road along Middle Road, Warwick. Sections of this stretch will undergo rolling lane closures to accommodate these works.

The lane closures will commence on Monday, January 6<sup>th</sup>, 2025 through to Friday, February 21<sup>st</sup>, 2025. Working hours will be weekdays from 7:30 am through to possibly 6:00 pm.

Traffic controls will be under the direction of Ministry of Public Works & BELCO representatives with barricades, signs, cones and traffic lights.

**Motorists are advised to use detour routes from the west via South Road, Lighthouse Road, and Camp Hill. Detour routes coming from the east via Longford Road, Tamarind Vale and Burnt House Hill.**

The Ministry of Public Works encourages the full cooperation of the motoring public and apologises for any inconvenience that may result.
