**ROAD CLOSURE FOR CONTINUOUS PAVING WORKS**

**MONDAY, JANUARY 13<sup>th</sup>, 2025 TO MONDAY, FEBRUARY 20<sup>th</sup>, 2025**

The Ministry of Public Works wishes to inform the motoring public that the ongoing paving works on Middle Road, Warwick for the road section of Burnt House Hill and Tamarind Vale will require a full road closure.

Being that the road section is narrow through this stretch, the full road closure must be enforced to allow for the workers to expedite paving in a safer environment.

**Traffic will be detoured via Burnt House Hill, Harbour Road and Tamarind Vale. Access for local property owners will be granted throughout this stretch.**

The road closure will commence on Monday, January 13<sup>th</sup>, 2025 through to possibly Monday, January 20<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Working hours will be weekdays from 7:30 am through to possibly 6:00 pm.

Traffic controls will be under the direction of Ministry of Public Works representatives with barricades, signs, cones and traffic lights.
