CLASS 7 – Western Pleasure Horses and Ponies

**Angela Darrell Trophy in memory of Jason Jones &
Western Pleasure Junior Chmpion - donated by Mike Watson Performance Horses (top junior)**

The ideal mount will appear to be easy going and a pleasure to ride. To be shown at walk, jog (slow trot), and lope (slow canter) displaying both leads, both ways of the ring. To be shown on a loose rein and judged on performance and manners 60%; type, condition and conformation 30%; appointments 10%. Horses head carriage that is too high or too low should be penalized. Entries to be shown with a stock saddle with or without silver, but silver equipment will not count over a good working outfit. Horses to be shown in standard western shank bit with half inch flat chain or leather chin strap using one hand on reins. Although not recommended horses under five can be shown without discrimination with two hands against one handed riders provided they have a standard snaffle bit or bitless hackamore bosal. This applies to horses that have never been shown in a shank bit. Hackamore bits, nose bands, martingales and tie-downs are prohibited. No metal or leather devices in conjunction with or as part of the chin strap are allowed. Riders must wear western attire which includes western hat, long sleeve shirt, pants or jeans under chaps, or western frontier style pants, western boots, and western ties or neck pieces. Western jackets, vests, sweaters, spurs, and rope or reata are optional.

Must stand quietly while lined up, without assistance from an attendant, and must back ready. To be judged on manners, quality, suitability of pony to driver, performance and appointments.

Similar to the Utility Horse class, competitors will be required to navigate a series of obstacles which may include a small jump, opening, riding through and closing a gate, walking over a bridge or tarp, etc. After completing the course, competitors will be brought back and shown at walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. May be asked hand gallop. Horses to be judged on performance, way of going suitability to rider, and soundness. Horses will not be penalized for small blemishes. May be shown under English or western tack. All Juniors are required to wear hard hat with harness attached.

CLASS 16 – Puddle Jumping 0.80m (2'7") (Opt Time) Horses & Ponies**Ultimate Imaging Cup**

Height not to exceed 80m (2'7") OPT Time Horses & Ponies USEF Optimum Time Competition - Optimum Time in First Round (Table Iv Sec. I)- this competition is decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the time allowed. In the case of equality of faults, ties will be broken on the following basis: an Optimum Time (defined as 4 seconds less than the Time Allowed for the course) will be posted on the course plan: the horse with the time on the course closest to this Optimum Time (over or Under) will prevail in the tie, next closest next, etc.
