SINCLAIR PACKWOOD MEMORIAL BICYCLE ROAD RACE

FRIDAY, MAY 23RD, 2025

The Ministry of Public Works & Environment wishes to inform motorists that the Sinclair Packwood Memorial Bicycle Road Race will occur on Friday, May 23rd 2025, between 8:00 am and 10:00 am. The following roads will be affected:

- RACE ROUTE:** The race commences on York Street in St. George's and heading west towards Ferry Reach on Mullet Bay Road. Continue west along Mullet Bay Road onto the Swing Bridge then onto Kindley Field Road to The Causeway, then merge onto North Shore Road to head into Flatt's. Then heading up Flatt's Hill to merge onto Middle Road to continue west towards the City of Hamilton. Travel along Cavendish Road onto Reid Street. Continue west on Reid Street, to turn left onto Court Street then right onto Front Street heading west. From Front Street turn right onto Queen Street going north. Then turn right onto Church Street to head east, then turn left to onto Cedar Avenue, finish is just before Elliott Street.
- TRAFFIC CONTROL:** All motorists are expected to use caution and avoid collisions with race participants. The race route will be controlled by Police Officers and Race Marshals. Motorists must follow the instructions from the Police Officers and Race Marshals to assist with traffic control for this event.
- ROAD CLOSURES:** All roads on the race route will be closed to traffic while this bicycle race takes place. All motorists must also allow cyclists to participate and give way when directed by police and race officials.
- PARKING:** There will be no parking restrictions for the bicycle race. Motorists are permitted to park in designated parking bays along any part of the race route. Additionally, motorists must not block the race route or impede the participants.

The Ministry of Public Works & Environment wishes to encourage the full cooperation of the motoring public and apologises for any inconvenience that may result. In addition, the Bermuda Police are hereby authorised to "Close off" streets or portions of streets and authorise parking as the Commissioner of Police decides.
