

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1947

ROAD TRAFFIC (BERMUDA BICYCLE ASSOCIATION BERMUDA JUNIOR CYCLING ROAD RACE) ORDER 2025

The Minister responsible for works and engineering, in exercise of the power conferred by section 4 of the Road Traffic Act 1947, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Bermuda Bicycle Association Bermuda Junior Cycling Road Race) Order 2025.
2. This Order applies in respect of the Bermuda Bicycle Association Bermuda Junior Cycling Road Race (the “bicycle race”) on the roadways between Paget and Southampton Parishes to be held on Sunday, 15th June 2025.
3. The bicycle race will follow the route specified below.
4. The Commissioner of Police is hereby authorized to close roads or portions of roads and authorize parking as the Commissioner of Police decides in the interests of public safety.

RACE ROUTE: The race commences and finishes on South Road at Gulfstream restaurant in Southampton. Travelling easterly along South Road then turning left on to St. Paul’s Lane in Paget, then turn left on to Middle Road and travel west towards Lighthouse Road, then turn left on to Lighthouse Road in Southampton and continue until making another left turn on to South Road and proceed east to the finish line.

TRAFFIC CONTROL: The bicycle race will commence on Sunday, 15th June 2025 at 8:00am and is expected to conclude by 11:00am. All motorists are expected to use caution and to avoid collision with race participants. The race route will be under the control of the police and race officials. Motorists must follow instructions from race officials to assist with traffic control for this event.

ROADS CLOSED: There will be no roads closed to traffic while the bicycle race takes place.

PARKING: There will be no parking restrictions in place for the bicycle race, with motorists permitted to park in designated parking bays along any part of the race route. Additionally, motorists must not block the race route or impede the participants in the bicycle race.

ROAD TRAFFIC (BERMUDA BICYCLE ASSOCIATION BERMUDA JUNIOR CYCLING ROAD RACE) (VARIATION OF SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2025


The Minister responsible for works and engineering, in exercise of the power conferred by section 7(2A) of the Road Traffic Act 1947, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Bermuda Bicycle Association Bermuda Junior Cycling Road Race) (Variation of Speed Limits) Order 2025.
2. This Order applies to the contestants and to the vehicles attendant on the contestants in the Bermuda Bicycle Association Bermuda Junior Cycling Road Race on roadways between Paget and Southampton Parishes to be held on Sunday, 15th June 2025.
3. The speed limits fixed by section 7(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Act 1947 are hereby varied to the extent specified in the first column of the Schedule in respect of the contestants and the vehicles attendant on the contestants in the Bermuda Bicycle Association Bermuda Junior Cycling Road Race.
4. The relevant roads or parts thereof specified in the second column of the Schedule are hereby declared to be subject, at the times specified in the third column of the Schedule, in respect of the contestants and the vehicles attendant on the contestants in the Bermuda Bicycle Association Bermuda Junior Cycling Road Race, to the speed limit specified in the first column thereof.
