AMENDED LANE CLOSURE HARBOUR ROAD CHAPEL LANE TO LOVER'S LANE, PAGET PARISH FOR

WALL INVESTIGATION DUE TO ACCIDENT MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 15th, 2025, TO FURTHER NOTICE

The Ministry of Public Works & Environment advises the motoring public that a single-lane closure remains in effect on Harbour Road between Chapel Lane and Lover's Lane in Paget Parish.

Due to damage to a wall from the accident on Friday, 12 September 2025, to allow travel in both directions, the Ministry of Public Works and Environment will be implementing traffic lights. Ministry personnel with stop-and-go signs will be stationed during morning and evening rush hours. This will ease congestion during peak hours.

Due to the narrow lane width on Harbour Road through this single-lane closure stretch, all trucks licensed with IN, HA, HC (Exempt garbage trucks) are prohibited from using this section of Harbour Road at any time. Truck drivers are instructed to use Middle Road or South Road as alternative routes. This heavy licensed truck restriction will be in effect throughout this lane closure, and if needed, it will be enforced through the Bermuda Police Service.

Motorists should anticipate delays and are encouraged to plan by using Middle Road and South Road where possible.

The Ministry of Public Works & Environment encourages the full cooperation of the motoring public and apologises for any inconvenience that may result. This road traffic notice will remain in effect until investigations are complete and repair works are implemented.
