THURSDAY, 23RD OCTOBER 2025 UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment wishes to advise the motoring public that an emergency lane closure is taking place on Harrington Sound Road near Shark Hole to investigate a hole found in the asphalt surface.

The single-lane closures will commence immediately in the eastbound lane up the hill from Shark Hole.

Investigation work will take place between the hours of 7:30 am to 3:00 pm.

Traffic Control will be monitored by Ministry of Public Works and Environment representatives, utilizing a traffic light and signs.

Motorists are urged to exercise caution when traveling along Harrington Sound Road, both day and night, and to expect delays during the investigation period.

To minimize disruption, drivers are encouraged to use detour route via North Shore Road.

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment appreciates the public's cooperation and apologizes for any inconvenience that may result, as we work to improve road safety.
