**ROAD CLOSURE FOR VEGETATION CLEARANCE
BLACKWATCH PASS
PEMBROKE PARISH**

**SATURDAYS FROM SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 22ND, 2025 TO SATURDAY,
DECEMBER 13TH, 2025**

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment wishes to inform the motoring public that there will be a full road closure on Blackwatch Pass in Pembroke Parish, to accommodate vegetation clearance along the cliff top.

The full road closure will occur on Saturdays only, commencing on November 22nd, 2025, until December 13th, 2025. Working hours will be between 7:30 am and 4:00 pm. The road closure extends the entire length of Blackwatch Pass.

Traffic control will be under the direction of representatives from the Ministry of Public Works and Environment.

Motorists are advised to avoid the area and use alternative routes via Berkeley Road, Langton Hill, The Glebe Road, and Roberts Avenue.

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment encourages the full cooperation of the motoring public and apologises for any inconvenience that may result.
