TEMPORARY LANE CLOSURES AND SIDEWALK CLOSURES FOR LINK BERMUDA TRENCH WORKS

MONDAY, 24TH OF NOVEMBER 2025 TO FRIDAY, 19TH DECEMBER 2025

The Ministry of Public Works & Environment wishes to inform the motoring public that there will be a lane closure on Middle Road between Kilderry Lane and Store Hill, Smiths Parish, to continue with trench work from the sidewalk and entering Middle Road.

The Middle Road trenching work will commence on Monday, November 24, 2025, and continue through Friday, December 19, 2025.

During this period, motorists travelling eastbound and westbound along Middle Road should expect delays due to the use of temporary traffic lights to facilitate the work safely.

Detour routes will be available via Hermitage Road, Barkers Hill and Vessey Street. The Ministry of Public Works and Environmental recommend that all eastbound traffic utilise Hermitage Road to avoid congestion on Middle Road from Vesey Street to Store Hill during the trenching hours.

The work hours will be from 7:30 am to possibly 6:00 pm.

The traffic controls will be under the direction of Invisible Trenching representatives with traffic lights and stop-and-go signs.

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment encourages the full cooperation of the motoring & pedestrian public and apologises for any inconvenience that may result.

Motorists are advised to slow down and follow traffic management.
