**MIDDLE ROAD – FROM MONTEPELIER ROAD TO TEE STREET, DEVONSHIRE
TEMPORARY LANE CLOSURES AND SIDEWALK CLOSURES FOR LINK BERMUDA
TRENCH WORKS**

WEDNESDAY, 19TH OF NOVEMBER 2025 TO FRIDAY, 19TH DECEMBER 2025

The Ministry of Public Works & Environment wishes to inform the motoring public that there will be a lane closure on Middle Road between Montpelier Road and Tee Street, Devonshire Parish, to accommodate trench work on the sidewalk and lane.

The Middle Road trenching work will commence on Wednesday, 19th of November 2025 and continue through Friday, 19th of December 2025.

During this period, motorists travelling eastbound and westbound along Middle Road should expect delays due to the use of temporary traffic lights. While the majority of trenching will occur along the sidewalk, there will be occasions where a lane will need to be closed to facilitate the work safely.

Detour routes will be available via Tee Street, Montpelier Road and Flora Duffy Hill.

The work hours will be this weekend from 7:30 am to possibly 6:00 pm.

The traffic controls will be under the direction of Invisible Trenching representatives with traffic lights and stop-and-go signs.

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment encourage the full cooperation of the motoring & pedestrian public and apologizes for any inconvenience that may result.

Motorists are advised to slow down and follow traffic management.
