BERMUDA UNION OF TEACHERS - 1.6k & 5k RUN/WALK

SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 1ST, 2026

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment wishes to inform motorists that the Bermuda Union of Teachers 1.6k and 5k Run/Walk will occur on Sunday, February 1st, 2026, between 8:30 am and 11:00 am. The following roads will be affected:

RACE ROUTES: The 1.6 km race commences and concludes at the West Pembroke School compound. The participants exit left onto North Shore Road and proceed West to the turnaround point. They traverse the turnaround point and head East on North Shore Road to return to the finish line at the West Pembroke School.

The 5 km race commences and concludes at the West Pembroke School compound. The participants turn left onto North Shore Road, continue to the intersection of North Shore Road, Spanish Point Road, and St. John's Road, and turn left onto St. John's Road. They exit the roundabout at the intersection of St. John's Road and Pitts Bay Road onto Pitts Bay Road. The participants turn left onto Serpentine Road and then left onto Woodlands Road. They turn right onto Euclid Avenue and then left onto St. John's Road. The participants turn right onto Berkeley Road and then left onto North Shore Road. They proceed West to the finish line at the West Pembroke School.

TRAFFIC CONTROL: The races will commence on Sunday, February 1st, 2026, at 8:30 am and are expected to conclude by 11:00 am. Race Marshals will direct traffic along the route. All motorists are expected to use caution and avoid collisions with the race participants. Motorists are asked to follow the Race Marshals' instructions to assist with traffic control for this event.

ROAD CLOSURES: There will be no road closures for this event.

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment encourages the full cooperation of the motoring public and apologises for any inconvenience that may result. In addition, the Bermuda police are hereby authorised to "Close off" streets or portions of streets and authorise parking as the Commissioner of Police decides.
