**EMERGENCY LANE CLOSURES
FOR
BELCO TRENCH WORKS**

IMMEDIATELY THROUGH END OF FEBRUARY 2026

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment wishes to inform the motoring public that an emergency closure will be in effect along the sidewalk on Stokes Point Road and Mullet Bay Road for BELCO trench work. This trench work is needed to repair a vault failure on Ferry Road.

This trench work shall take place at numerous sidewalk locations & grass shoulders along Mullet Bay Road near Ferry Road, and along Stokes Point Road from the old bridge crossing to Mullet Bay Road.

It is anticipated that this trench work will continue until the end of February 2026.

There should only be minor delays on the roads.

The work hours will be Monday through Friday, 7:30 am to 6:00 pm.

Traffic controls will be managed by BELCO representatives, with cones and stop-and-go signs.

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment encourages full cooperation from the motoring public and apologises for any inconvenience this may cause.
