BERMUDA CONNECTION 5K & 10K RACES

SATURDAY, MARCH 7th, 2026

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment wishes to inform motorists that the Bermuda Connection 5k and 10k races will occur on Saturday, March 7th, 2026, between 7:00 am and 11:00 am. The following roads will be affected:

RACE ROUTES: The 5k race commences at the Hamilton Princess Beach Club entrance located at the intersection of South Road and Sonesta Drive. The participants turn left onto Lighthouse Road, then left onto the Railway Trail. They continue on the Railway Trail, then turn right onto Church Road. The participants turn left onto Middle Road, then right onto the Railway Trail. They exit onto Middle Road and turn left onto South Road at Barnes Corner. The participants continue on South Road and exit at Sonesta Drive to the finish line at Boat Bay.

The 10k race commences at the Hamilton Princess Beach Club entrance located at the intersection of South Road and Sonesta Drive. The participants turn left onto Lighthouse Road, then right onto the Railway Trail. They proceed East to the turnaround point along the Railway Trail, just before Pearman's Hill West. The participants head West along the Railway Trail, then turn right onto Church Road. They turn left onto Middle Road, then right onto the Railway Trail. The participants exit onto Middle Road and turn left onto South Road at Barnes Corner. They continue on South Road and exit at Sonesta Drive to the finish line at Boat Bay.

TRAFFIC CONTROL: The races will commence on Saturday, March 7th, 2026, at 7:00 am and are expected to conclude by 11:00 am. Race Marshals and Police Officers will direct traffic along the route. All motorists are expected to use caution and avoid collisions with the race participants. Motorists are asked to follow the Race Marshals' and Police Officers' instructions to assist with traffic control for this event.

ROAD CLOSURES: There will be no road closures for this event.

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment encourages the full cooperation of the motoring public and apologises for any inconvenience that may result. Should there be any questions regarding this event, please direct them to the race representative, Mark Harris, at 535-1609.

In addition, the Bermuda police are hereby authorised to "Close off" streets or portions of streets and authorise parking as the Commissioner of Police decides.
