**LINDO'S TO LINDO'S – 10K RUN & 4 MILE WALK**

**SUNDAY, MARCH 8<sup>th</sup>, 2026**

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment wishes to inform motorists that the Lindo 's-to-Lindo's 10k Run and 4 Mile Walk will occur on Sunday, March 8<sup>th</sup>, 2026, between 8:30 am and 10:30 am. The following roads will be affected:

**RACE ROUTES:** The 10k race commences at Lindo's Home Foods Store on Middle Road, Warwick. The participants continue East along Middle Road, then proceed onto South Road. They turn left onto Collectors Hill and proceed West onto Middle Road. The participants turn left onto Chaingate Hill, then right onto Watlington Road East. They continue to the finish line at Lindo's Devonshire car park.

The 4-mile walk initially follows the same route as the 10k race. Instead of proceeding to Collectors Hill, the participants turn left from South Road onto Brighton Hill Road. They then turn right onto Watlington Road East and proceed to the finish line at Lindo's Devonshire car park.

**TRAFFIC CONTROL:** The races will commence on Sunday, March 8<sup>th</sup>, 2026, at 8:30 am and are expected to conclude by 10:30 am. Race Marshals will direct traffic along the route, with Police Officers stationed at Paget Traffic Lights, Trimmingham Roundabout and Collectors Hill Traffic Lights. All motorists are expected to use caution and avoid collisions with the race participants. Motorists are asked to follow the Race Marshals' and Police Officers' instructions to assist with traffic control for this event.

**ROAD CLOSURES:** There will be no road closures for this event.

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment encourages the full cooperation of the motoring public and apologises for any inconvenience that may result. **In addition, the Bermuda police are hereby authorised to "Close off" streets or portions of streets and authorise parking as the Commissioner of Police decides.**
