MITCHELL HOUSE | Kent Street ST. GEORGE'S HISTORICAL SOCIETY MUSEUM.

FREE ENTRY (closing at 4pm): Step back in time to the early days of Bermuda at Mitchell House, a Museum operated by the St. George's Historical Society since the 1920s. The house was built in 1731 and remains much as it was nearly 300 years ago.

THE GLOBE HOTEL MUSEUM & TRUSTWORTHY GIFT SHOP, York Street. FREE ENTRY

(closing at 4pm): In the heart of the World Heritage Site, you will find Globe Museum in one of Bermuda's earliest structures. Within its grand architecture, view films on St. George's, learn about the island's early settlement, and explore the expansive "Rogues and Runners" exhibit on Bermuda's role in the US Civil War.

ST. PETER'S CHURCH | York Street

Visit Their Majesties Chapel, St. Peter's Church, the oldest Anglican Church outside the British Isles and the oldest Protestant church in continuous use in the New World. Use the 'scavenger hunt' paper to find cool artefacts around this important historic site.
