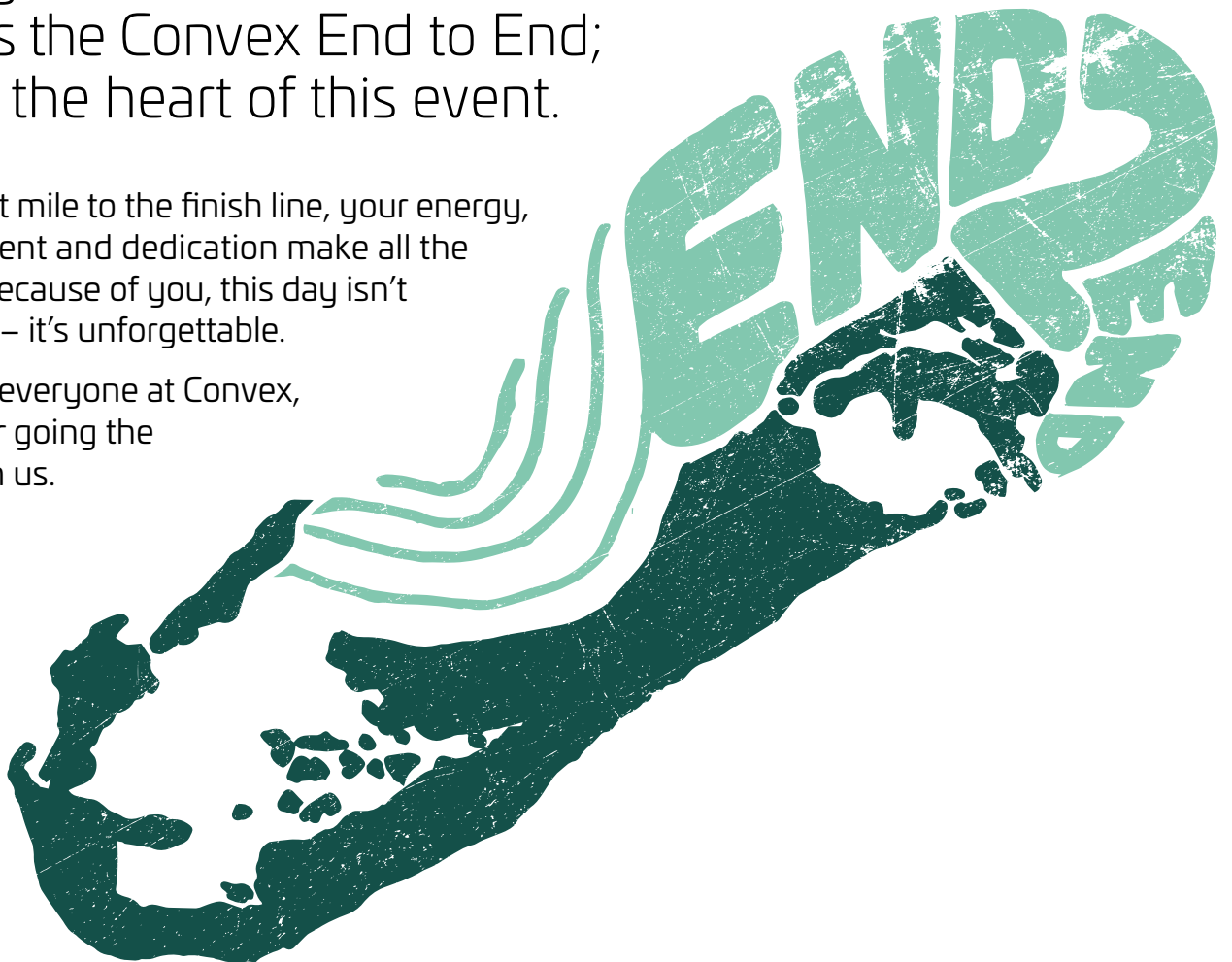

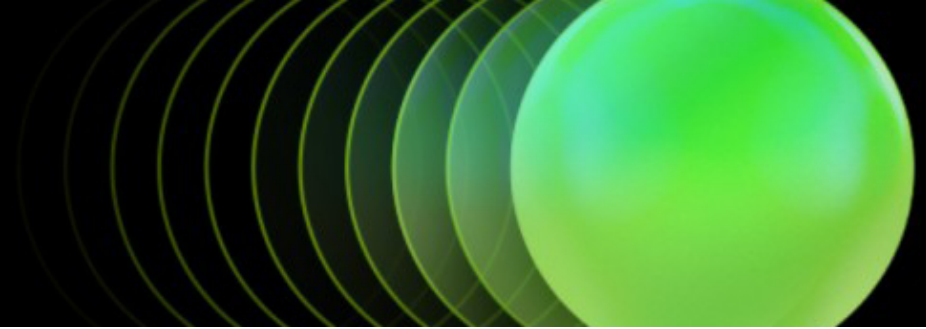

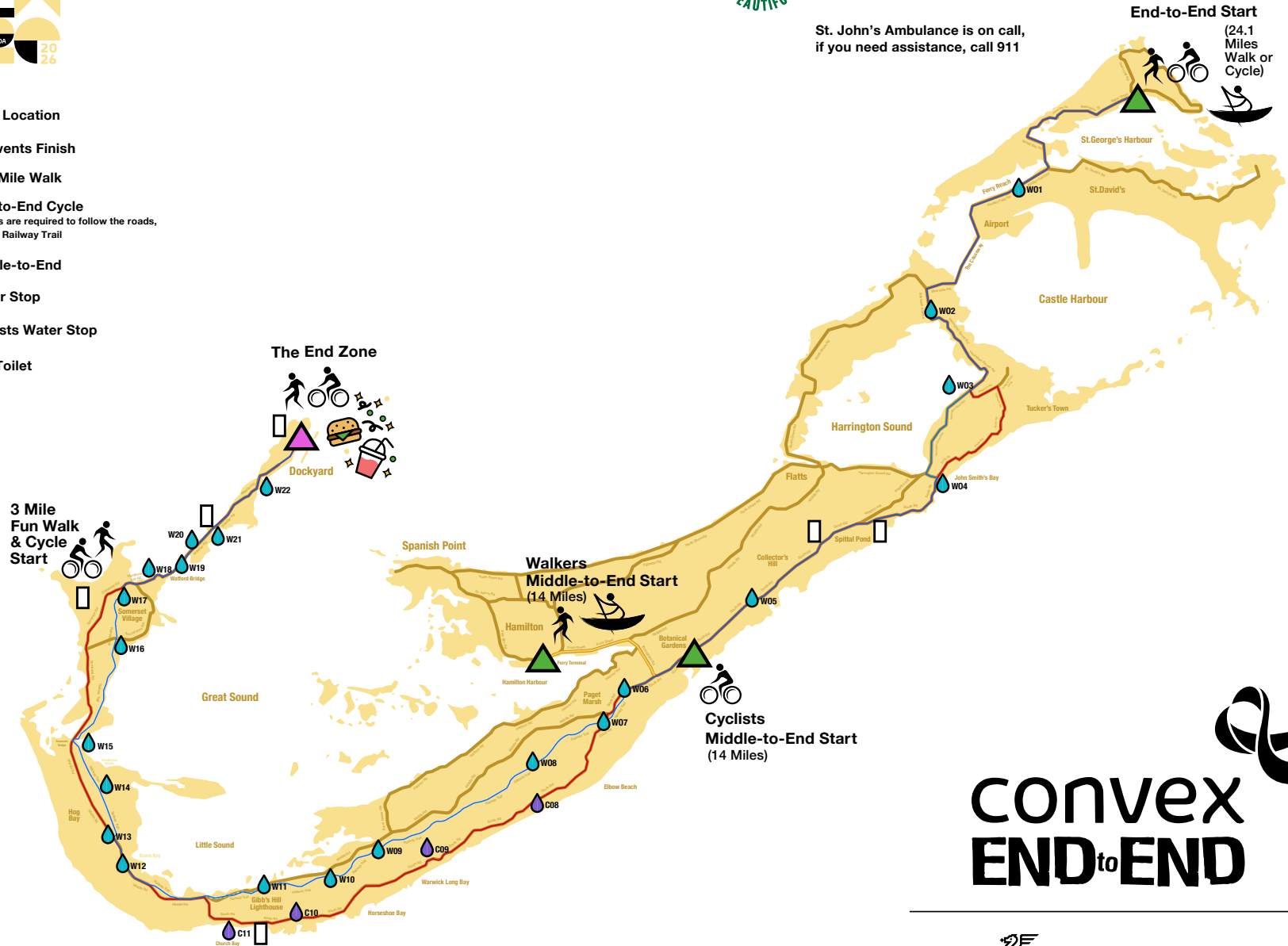

# OUR 2026 CHARITIES

## GREAT FUN FOR A GREAT CAUSE

The ETE Charitable Trust is a registered charity (#558). The focus of the End-to-End remains steadfast on addressing the pressing needs of the Bermuda community. The proceeds generated from the 2026 End-to-End event will be dedicated to funding non-sectarian charitable programmes in Bermuda, as well as supporting operational expenses that contribute to the preservation and improvement of the Bermuda Railway Trail, the Bermuda community and local families.



### Coalition for the Protection of Children

The Coalition for the Protection of Children works to prevent child abuse and neglect through advocacy, education, and collaboration. Its programmes focus on strengthening families, promoting child wellbeing, and raising awareness to create safer environments for children.



### Dementia Bermuda

Dementia Bermuda provides support, education, and advocacy for people living with dementia and their caregivers. Services include community programmes, caregiver resources, and public awareness initiatives to improve quality of life and reduce stigma.



### Knowledge Quest Ltd

Knowledge Quest provides higher education opportunities to Bermudians of limited financial means, along with professional development through mentorships, networking, and internships with donor companies. Its mission is to bridge financial gaps, enhance the local workforce, and support community growth.



### SkillCraft Bermuda

## It Takes a Village Foundation

It Takes a Village Foundation empowers Bermudian families by ensuring that every pregnant woman, regardless of financial status, has access to programs that support a healthier pregnancy, birth and early parenting experience. Programs include community birth classes, nutrition support, birth and post-partum doula support, as well as voucher, diaper, breast-pump provision and trauma therapeutic services.



## Bermuda Optimist Dinghy Association

The Bermuda Optimist Dinghy Association introduces young sailors to competitive sailing in a safe and structured environment. The programme develops seamanship, teamwork, and confidence while fostering a lifelong love of the sport.



## Performance Pathways

Performance Pathways supports athletes through training, education, and performance development. The programme focuses on long-term athlete growth, helping participants reach their potential both in sport and beyond.



## Future Leaders Bermuda

Future Leaders Bermuda equips young people with leadership, career readiness, and life skills through workshops, mentorship, and experiential learning. The programme prepares participants to become confident, engaged contributors to their communities.

# SAFETY TIPS & IMPORTANT INFORMATION

## SAFETY TIPS

- Road marshals and event safety features are available from 7:00am – 4:00pm only
- It is important to start your event at the listed start time
- The event closes at 4:00pm
- Take sunscreen and a hat and drink plenty of water
- Wear good walking shoes
- Cycle helmets are mandatory
- Be careful and look both ways before crossing roadways

## TRANSPORT

**Car:** Please use public transportation whenever possible

**Bus:** Refer to regular public bus schedule. Ride free with event number.

**Ferry:** Convex End-to-End participants ride free on all Blue Route ferries during regular service throughout event day, on showing their number tag

- Ferry departure times as published by Sea Express. Capacity of ferries is 350 persons maximum
- Ferries from Dockyard are 12:30pm, 1:45pm, 2:15pm, 3:00pm, 4:00pm, 4:30pm, 5:00pm and 5:45pm. There will also be an additional boat lift from Dockyard at the following times: 1:45pm, 3:00pm, 4:30pm and 5:00pm
- ETE Cyclists: Ferry departs Hamilton at 7:30am for the 9:00am start
- Tickets are available at \$15 each for bike transfer. Space is limited. First come, first served

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Event number must be displayed at all times during the event to receive free transport, participant extras and a medal at the Finish

## **5. WHAT'S THE BEST WAY TO GET TO THE START LINE OF MY EVENT?**

All participants ride free on the buses and Blue Route ferries on event day. Refer to the regular public schedule, or for ETE walkers and cyclists, take the bus or ferry to St. Georges:

- 6:15am Bus for walkers from the Bus Terminal, Hamilton to St. George's
- 7:30am Ferry for cyclists from the Ferry Terminal, Hamilton to St. George's
- Tokens are available at the event office for both the bus and the ferry

## **6. WILL WATER BOTTLES BE PROVIDED AT THE WATER STOPS?**

No, please help us be sustainable and bring your own water bottle. You can fill it up at the water stops.

## **7. ARE THERE RESTROOMS ALONG THE ROUTE?**

Yes there is a restroom at every water stop, these are marked on the Event Map on page 7, and listed on page 8. There are also public restrooms available in the Clocktower Mall at the finish.

## **8. WHAT IS THE ROUTE FOR CYCLISTS?**

Cyclists should use Middle and South Roads. There will be special cyclist water stops along the route. The Railway Trail is reserved for walkers only.

# SUSTAINABILITY

The End-to-End (ETE) is committed to ESG initiatives. This is demonstrated by the grassroots support of the environment and sustainability for Bermuda, both of which are considered in conjunction with the organisation of the annual event. Additionally, we are particularly proud of our commitment to the Bermuda Railway Trail.

## THE ETE'S HISTORY OF SUPPORT FOR SUSTAINABILITY

<b>2004</b>	ETE's Railway Trail vision project. In our role as a steward of the Trail, ETE sponsored a consultation by trail experts from Washington DC to determine which enhancements were possible
<b>2008</b>	ETE funded Green Rock's BYOB campaign - the first on the Island
	ETE instituted a BYOB policy for the event, with water stops equipped with 5-gallon bottles on cradles (Pure Water donated and continues to do so) Estimate of plastic bottles distributed by our water stops in previous years - 30,000! In 2008 - none!
<b>2014</b>	ETE Catlin Marin Grant - \$100K - Educational, research and/or preservation of our marine environment
<b>2015</b>	Along with KBB, Greenrock, Ministry of Public Works Waste Management and BEST, ETE was a founding member of the Bermuda Green Cooperative that initiated a Leave no Trace policy for all events on the Island
	ETE event was designated as a Green Water stop Event with a Leave no Trace goal
<b>2017</b>	ETE donates three benches along the Railway Trail
<b>2021</b>	ETE Board determines that annual funding for the enhancement of the Railway Trail will be part of the charitable giving process each year
<b>2022</b>	ETE supports Bermuda National Trust's 3 nature reserves adjacent to the Railway Trail and provides oases of green and quiet space for uses of the trail and local residents
	ETE conducts a thorough review of its practices and supplies to enhance its sustainability practices
<b>2023</b>	ETE supports the BZS micro forest project that establishes ecosystems along the Railway Trail
	ETE no longer supplies sponsored water bottles in the entry kit. The event poly giveaway bag has been changed to a cloth version. Deloitte supplied eco flip-flops to all participants
<b>2024</b>	ETE goes paperless with our digital event guide

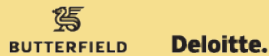
