**LANE CLOSURE
FOR
DIGICEL TO REPAIR UNDERGROUND CABLES,**

WEDNESDAY, 15TH APRIL 2026, THROUGH FRIDAY, 17TH APRIL 2026

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment wishes to inform the motoring public that a Lane closure will take place on Crow Lane just south of Flora Duffy Hill in Pembroke. The roadway has two lanes; however, only one lane will be closed under this notice. Motorists will be directed to use the remaining open lanes during the work.

The Lane Closure procedure will commence on Wednesday, 15th April 2026, and continue through Friday, 17th April 2026.

Working hours will be from 9 am to 4:00 pm each day.

The traffic controls will be under the direction of the Invisible trenching firm, and they will use barriers and stop-and-go personnel to manage traffic within this closed lane area.

During the lane closure, Digicel's underground cable will be repaired with a sidewalk adjacent to the lane. There will be no trenching in the road, but Equipment is needed to access the underground cable, hence the lane will be blocked.

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment encourages full cooperation from the motoring public and apologises for any inconvenience that may arise.
