The Ministry of Public Works and Environment wishes to inform the motoring public that a One-Way Traffic Flow will take place on Langton Hill in Pembroke from North Shore Road to Mount Hill. Residents will have access during this one-way traffic flow procedure.

The One-Way procedure will commence on Tuesday, 07th April 2026, and continue through Wednesday, 08th April 2026.

Working hours will be from 9am am to 4:00 pm each day.

The traffic controls will be under the direction of the Bermuda Arborist firm, and they will use barriers and stop-and-go personnel to manage traffic within the one-way system.

During the road closure, trees will be removed along the road edge will be performed. Please allow crew members to perform this work without impediment.
