The Ministry of Public Works and Environment wishes to inform the motoring public that a single-lane closure will occur on Harrington Sound Road in Smith's Parish for water valve works.

The single-lane closure commences on Tuesday, 14th April 2026, and continues through Wednesday, 15th April 2026.

Working hours will be from 7:30 am to 5:00 pm.

The traffic controls will be under the direction of representatives from Island Construction representatives, using stop-and-go signs.

Motorists are advised to use detour routes via Middle Road, Harrington Hundreds Road or North Shore Road to avoid this lane closure.

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment encourages full cooperation from the motoring public and apologises for any inconvenience that may arise.
