**CAMBRIDGE CLASSIC 5K AND 10K RACES**

**SUNDAY, APRIL 19<sup>TH</sup>, 2026**

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment wishes to inform motorists that the Cambridge Classic 5k and 10k Races will occur on Sunday, April 19<sup>th</sup>, 2026, between 8:30 am and 10:00 am. The following roads will be affected:

**RACE ROUTES:** The 5k race commences and concludes at the Cambridge Beaches Resort. The participants turn left onto Cambridge Road, then right onto Mangrove Bay Road. They proceed to Malabar Road, then turn right onto Kitchener Road. The participants turn right onto Runway Lane, then left onto Malabar Road. They continue on Mangrove Bay Road, turn left onto Cambridge Road, and proceed to the finish line.

The 10k race commences and concludes at the Cambridge Beaches Resort. The participants turn left onto Cambridge Road, then right onto Mangrove Bay Road. They proceed to Malabar Road, then continue to Cockburn Road, and finally to Freeport Drive. The participants traverse the turnaround point at the Clocktower Parade and return to Freeport Drive. They continue on Cockburn Road, then turn onto Malabar Road. The participants turn left onto Kitchener Road, right onto Runway Lane, then left onto Malabar Road. They continue on Mangrove Bay Road, turn left onto Cambridge Road, and proceed to the finish line.

**TRAFFIC CONTROL:** The races will commence on Sunday, April 19<sup>th</sup>, 2026, at 8:30 am and are expected to conclude by 10:00 am. Race Marshals will direct traffic along the route. All motorists are expected to use caution and avoid collisions with the race participants. Motorists are asked to follow the Race Marshals' instructions to assist with traffic control for this event.

**ROAD CLOSURES:** There will be no road closures for this event.

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment encourages the full cooperation of the motoring public and apologises for any inconvenience that may result. Should there be any questions regarding this event, please direct them to the race representative, Marla Smith, at 295-0487.

**In addition, the Bermuda police are hereby authorised to "Close off" streets or portions of streets and authorise parking as the Commissioner of Police decides.**
