BERMUDA BICYCLE ASSOCIATION BERMUDA JR CYCLING ROAD RACE

SUNDAY, MAY 3RD, 2026

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment wishes to inform motorists that the Bermuda Bicycle Association Bermuda Jr Cycling Road Race will occur on Sunday, May 3rd, 2026, between 8:00 am and 11:00 am. The following roads will be affected:

RACE ROUTE: The race starts and finishes on South Road, outside of the Gulf Stream compound. The participants head East, turning left onto St. Paul's Lane. They turn left onto Middle Road and proceed West to Lighthouse Road. They turn left onto Lighthouse Road, left onto South Road, and head East to the finish line.

TRAFFIC CONTROL: The bicycle race will commence on Sunday, May 3rd, 2026, at 8:00 am and is expected to conclude by 11:00 am. Race Marshals will direct traffic along the route. All motorists are expected to use caution and avoid collisions with the race participants. Motorists are asked to follow the Race Marshals' instructions to assist with traffic control for this event.

ROAD CLOSURES: There will be no road closures for this event.

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment wishes to encourage the full cooperation of the motoring public and apologises for any inconvenience that may result. If you have any questions regarding this event, please contact Peter Dunne, the race representative, at 704-8614.

In addition, the Bermuda police are hereby authorised to "Close off" streets or portions of streets and authorise parking as the Commissioner of Police decides.
