THE ROAD TRAFFIC (VARIATION OF SPEED LIMITS) (No. 43) ORDER 2026

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Minister charged with responsibility for Works by Section 7(2A) and (2B) of the Road Traffic Act, 1947, the following Order is hereby made: -

1. (i) This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Variation of Speed Limits) (No. 43) Order 2024.
- (ii) This Order applies to the contestants and to the attendant vehicles to the contestants of the Sinclair Packwood Memorial Cycle Race of Friday, 22nd May 2024.
2. (i) The speed limits fixed by Section 7(2) of the Road Traffic Act 1947 are hereby varied to the extent specified in the first column of the Schedule in respect of the Sinclair Packwood Memorial Cycle Race.
- (iii) The roads or parts thereof specified in the second column of the Schedule are hereby declared to be subject at the times specified in the third column of the Schedule to the speed limit specified in the first column thereof.

SCHEDULE

SPEED LIMIT	ROADS	TIMES
75 kilometres per hour	Commencing at Somerset Road, Sandys at the junction of Cambridge Road and travel in an easterly direction along Somerset Road, easterly direction (Sandys Parish) to Somerset Bridge, on to Middle Road, easterly direction (Sandys, Southampton and Warwick Parishes) to the junction of Burnt House Hill, northerly direction (Warwick Parish), Burnt House Hill on to Harbour Road, easterly direction (Warwick and Paget Parishes), on to The Lane, northerly direction (Paget Parish), on to Crow Lane westerly direction (Paget, Devonshire, Pembroke Parishes), into the City of Hamilton and the race then finishes just before Elliot street.	7.30 am to 10:00 am

BERMUDA DAY EVENTS

FRIDAY, 22nd MAY 2026

ROUTES:

1. Sinclair Packwood Memorial Cycle Race:

Somerset Road, across Somerset Bridge, Middle Road, Burnt House Hill, Harbour Road, The Lane, Crow Lane, into the City of Hamilton, leaving the City of Hamilton, the race then finishes just before Elliot Street.

2. Marathon Derby:

Somerset Road, across Somerset Bridge, Middle Road, Burnt House Hill, Harbour Road, The Lane, Crow Lane, into the City of Hamilton, leaving the City of Hamilton on Cedar Avenue, Marsh Folly Road, to Dutton Avenue, and continue onto North Street.

3. Junior Classic Run:

See city of Hamilton Traffic Order for their street closures (start of the race), leaving City of Hamilton on Cedar Avenue, Marsh Folly Road, Dutton Avenue, and continue onto North Street

4. Parade Route:

Starting in the City of Hamilton for their street closures (start of parade), leaving the City of Hamilton on Cedar Avenue, Marsh Folly Road, and finishing on Dutton Avenue.

TRAFFIC CONTROL:

All traffic including pedal cyclists (but excluding the official vehicles preceding the Sinclair Packwood Memorial Bicycle Race, Marathon Derby Race Department of Transportation buses and emergency vehicles will be diverted off the half marathon and cycle race route between the hours of 7:30 am and 12:00 pm.

At the discretion of the Bermuda Police Service, traffic may be permitted to travel in the opposite direction of the Bermuda Day Half Marathon runners except on Burnt House Hill, Harbour Road, The lane between Stowe Hill and Crow Lane Roundabout.

ROADS CLOSED:

Somerset Road

Between Warren Simmons Community Field and Somerset Bridge will be closed to all traffic from 7:30am to 12:00pm

**Middle Road, Sandys,
Southampton, & Warwick**

Between Somerset Bridge and Burnt House Hill will be closed to all traffic from 7.30am to 12:00pm

**Burnt House Hill, Harbour
Road, and The Lane**

Between Middle Road in Warwick and North Roundabout in Paget will be closed to all traffic from 7:30 am to 12:00 pm.

Chapel Road

Between Middle Road and Harbour Road from 7.30am until 12.30pm, to allow emergency vehicle access.

Trimingham Hill

Between South Road and Crow Lane will be closed to all traffic except for buses from 7.30am to 12:00pm.

Crow Lane

North Roundabout (The Lane) to City of Hamilton boundary (westbound traffic only) from 7.30 am until opened by Bermuda Police Service.

Stowe Hill

Between South Road and Harbour Road will be closed to all traffic except to allow access to residents from 7:30 am to 12:00 pm.

Pitt's Bay Road	Between Woodbourne Avenue and Bermudiana Road will be closed to all traffic from 8:00 am until opened by Bermuda Police Service.
Canal Road	Between Marsh Folly Road and Laffan Street will be closed to traffic except to allow access to residents from 7:30 am to 12:00 pm.
Cedar Avenue	From City Boundary to the St John's Road junction will be closed to all traffic from 7:30 am until open by Bermuda Police Service.
Marsh Folly Road	From St John's Road to St Monica's Road junction from 8.00 am until opened by the Bermuda Police service.
Marsh Folly Road and St Monica's Road	Traffic will only be allowed to travel eastbound from the junction of St Monica's Road and Marsh Folly Road.
Dutton Avenue	North Street to Marsh Folly Road will be closed to all traffic from 6:00 am to 8:00 pm.
Black Watch Pass	Closed from 7.30 am until opened by the Bermuda Police Service.

NO PARKING:

Burnt House Hill, Harbour Road, The Lane	Between Middle Road in Warwick and North Roundabout in Paget from 7:30 am until 12:30 pm.
Chapal Road	Between Middle Road and Harbour Road from 7.30am until 12.30pm, to allow emergency vehicle access.
Stowe Hill	No parking from 7:30 am to 12:30 pm.
Pitt's Bay Road	Between Woodbourne Avenue and Bermudiana Road, from 7:30 am until opened by Bermuda Police Service.
Marsh Folly	Between St John's Road and Dutton Avenue, from 7:30 am until opened by Bermuda Police Service.
Dutton Avenue	Between Marsh Folly Road and North Street, from 6.00 a.m. until opened by Bermuda Police Service.

In addition, the Bermuda Police Service is hereby authorized to 'Close off' streets or portions of streets, restrict and authorize parking as the Commissioner of Police decides.
