TEMPORARY LANE CLOSURES FOR LINK BERMUDA TRENCH WORKS

SATURDAY, 16TH MAY 2026 TO MONDAY, 18TH MAY 2026

The Ministry of Public Works & Environment wishes to inform the motoring public that there will be lane closures on Middle Road near Fort Hill Road, Devonshire Parish, to accommodate trench work in the area.

The Middle Road trenching work will commence on Saturday, 16th of May 2026 and continue through Monday, 18th May 2026.

During this period, motorists travelling eastbound and westbound along Middle Road should expect delays due to the use of temporary traffic lights.

Detour routes will be available via Tee Street, Montpelier Road and Flora Duffy Hill.

The work hours will be this weekend from 7:30 am to possibly 6:00 pm.

The traffic controls will be under the direction of Invisible Trenching representatives with traffic lights and stop-and-go signs.

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment encourages the full cooperation of the motoring & pedestrian public and apologises for any inconvenience that may result.

Motorists are advised to slow down and follow traffic management.
