ON CLEARWATER – SOUTHSIDE ROADS - ROADS CLOSED NOTICE

SATURDAY, 13th JUNE 2026: 9.00am – 12.00pm

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment wishes to inform motorists that the Clarien Bank / Bermuda Triathlon Association will be holding IRONKIDS Event: Saturday, 13th June 2026 between the hours of 9.00am & 12.00pm and on the following roads from Clearwater to Southside.

The Bicycle portion of the triathlon race route is as follows:

RACE ROUTE: Commencing at the Main Car Park Clearwater Beach the bicycle portion of the older children will race in a northerly direction along Cooper Island Road. At the roundabout of Cooper Island Road, Pepper Hall Road and Southside Road take the first exit (i.e. left) onto Southside Road travel in westerly direction until the junction with Tommy Fox Road. Take a left and continue in a westerly direction on Southside Road until the roundabout with Carter's Bay Road and Lower Gates Road. Proceed all the way around this roundabout and return in the direction the race came from along Southside Road in an easterly direction. Return back to Clearwater by the same route for the completion of lap 1.

TRAFFIC CONTROL: The bicycle race will commence on Saturday, 13th June 2026, at 9.00am and is expected to conclude by 12.00pm. Race Marshals and Police Officers will direct traffic along the route. All motorists are expected to use caution and avoid collisions with the race participants. Motorists are asked to follow the Race Marshals' and Police Officers' instructions to assist with traffic control for this event. **Bermuda Police Service officers will be located on the five key junctions in addition to race marshals to direct traffic.**

ROAD CLOSURES: Roads will be CLOSED while the three main races are ongoing and traffic will be allowed to proceed between each race.

Motorists are requested to show consideration for the participants by not impeding them or blocking the race route.

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment wishes to encourage the full cooperation of the motoring public and apologises for any inconvenience that may result. In addition, the Bermuda police are hereby authorised to "Close off" streets or portions of streets and authorise parking as the Commissioner of Police decides.
